
Below the crest of noble hue, the (twenty five) stands bold and true. Above the crest our motto bold, "Together We Thrive," displayed in gold.

The chain runs strong with a bond well tied, to the older Class of Seventy-Five. Their strength a star that shines so bright, guiding us with honor's light.






The eagle's claws and the swords they clasp, remind us all of dreams we grasp. United in purpose together we stand, ready to serve our home, our land.
